Camron Cozzi was a Bonney Lake student athlete Class of 2018. During Camron's sophomore year while playing select lacrosse he suffered a concussion. An injury which would aide in discovering the real reasons for his ongoing symptoms. On December 22, 2015, Camron was diagnosed with an inoperable brain tumor, Diffuse Intrinsic Pontine Glioma (DIPG).

Camron's news spread quickly throughout our communities of Bonney Lake, Sumner, and Lake Tapps. It also spread even further because of his involvement with lacrosse. Support would come from all over the United States. A blessing and a gift. The funds raised by our supporters would allow Camron to live 25 months longer than his original diagnosis.

Camron passed away on March 10, 2018, of his senior year. Paul, Cyndi, and Jordan (Class of 2016) decided together to honor him with the Camron Nicholas Cozzi Memorial Scholarship. A scholarship to give back to a community that surrounded them with love and hope during Camron's journey fighting DIPG.
